I put up several signs with well worn phrases in public space to reference the awareness of choices in every day life – but at the same time to highlight the insignificance of all those options. Ultimately, we should feel content and embrace whatever life may give to us.

480 DAYS TO DECIDE

There are several places at which the density of crucial decisions is rather high.

In Paris, I observed the emblematic buildings of the stock exchange (Bourse), the parliament (Assemblée Nationale), the high court (Palais de Justice), an airport tower (Orly), a hospital (Hôpital de la Salpêtrière) and the Madeleine for a certain period of time; and then took the same amount of images of these buildings as either the number of decisions being made, their duration or frequency, or the number of choices or deciders.
